Minutes

Mayor David Morris called to order a Special Session of the Searcy City Council. Mayor Morris gave the Invocation, with the pledge following, led by Alderman Steve Sterling. City Clerk Peggy Meads called the roll with the following Aldermen answering “present”: Logan Cothorn, Mary Ann Arnett, Jim Dixon, Steve Sterling, Dale English, Don Raney, Dale Brewer and Mark Derrick. Item (c) was a resolution to authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into a contract with James H. Cone, Inc., the low bidder on the airport terminal construction project. Mrs. Meads read the resolution in full. A motion was then made by Mr. Raney, seconded by Mr. Cothorn, to adopt the resolution. The resolution passed with the following voting “yes”: Arnett, Dixon, Sterling, English, Raney, Brewer, Derrick and Cothorn.

Item (d) on the agenda was an ordinance to authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into agreements for the development of South Sowell Street. Mr. Gibson stated that he had received a proposed agreement from the attorney for Wal-Mart, sent back his proposed revisions, and had not yet had the opportunity to review the current version of the proposed agreement. Mr. Raney stated that his client, the Searcy Special School District, had not yet approved the proposed agreement either. A motion was made by Mr. Brewer, seconded by Mr. Derrick, to defer consideration of the ordinance at this time, pending resolution of any changes and securing each party’s agreeing to the proposed language. Motion carried with the following voting “yes”: Dixon, Sterling, English, Raney, Brewer, Derrick, Cothorn and Arnett.

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn.
