

## ORDINANCE 2018 - 02

### AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF SEARCY TO CONDUCT BUSINESS WITH CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS WHO SERVE AS MEMBERS OF VARIOUS COMMISSIONS, BOARDS OR COMMITTEES OF THE CITY OF SEARCY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

The City Council of the City of Searcy, Arkansas, meeting in regular session, makes the following findings of fact and enacts the following provisions:

WHEREAS, the Searcy City Council recognizes the importance of certain goods and services provided to the City of Searcy; and

WHEREAS, the Searcy City Councils wishes to acknowledge the affiliation and approve the various positions held by Commission, Board and Committee members where they or their spouse hold a significant position with the business or organization with whom the City does business as listed below:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Searcy City Council adopts the following ordinance:

Section 1. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 14-42-107, the Searcy City Council specifically approves the affiliation support provided by these Commission, Board and Committee members of the City of Searcy, for their services to the City,

Section 2. The Searcy City Council specifically declares that it is in the best interest of the City to make certain purchases and receive certain services provided by the above listed affiliations of the various Commissions, Boards and Committees members.

Section 3. The provisions of this ordinance are separable and, upon any finding that any provision of this ordinance is unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be enforceable according to their terms.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolution or other acts of the City in conflict with the terms hereof are repealed to the extent of any such conflict.

Section 5. Emergency Clause. In light of the need to continue to do businesses with and receive certain services from the above listed business and organizations within the City of Searcy, an emergency is hereby declared and in order to provide for the continued peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Searcy, the provisions of this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the adoption of this ordinance and emergency clause.
